Dear Assemblymember Maienschein,

The San Diego Police Officers Association would like to express our appreciation for your efforts to author and pass AB 1641, which we believe will protect our neighborhoods from sexually violent predators.

AB 1641 codifies existing best practice by statutorily requiring all Sexually Violent Predators (SVP) to be GPS monitored while on a conditional release program. Because of the violent and heinous nature of an SVP's criminal conduct, it is important that the state provide clear statutory requirements to protect public safety.

We believe AB 1641 will clarify some ambiguities in the law and will help ensure the public's safety by establishing the protections needed when a sexually violent predator is on conditional release or has outpatient status.
